

Introduction of Bob Delaney

Bob Delaney was elected as the Member of Provincial Parliament in the riding of Mississauga West on October 2, 2003. He is the Parliamentary Assistant to the *Ontario Seniors Secretariat*. Bob has served on, or chaired, four Standing Committees at the Ontario Legislature, most recently the Standing Committee on the Legislative Assembly.

Bob lives in the Churchill Meadows neighbourhood of Mississauga. He was born in Montreal, and has also lived in Metro Toronto and in Vancouver.

Bob received his Bachelor's Degree in physics from Concordia University in Montreal. He earned a Masters Degree in Business Administration from Simon Fraser University in British Columbia. He has also received his accreditation from the Canadian Public Relations Society.

In the private sector prior to his election, Bob worked in corporate communications, consulting and marketing roles. Bob became an accomplished web developer in the 1990s. He is a co-author of the book *High Value IT Consulting*, published by Osborne McGraw Hill in March, 2003. Bob also taught in the School of Business Studies in Continuing Education at Ryerson University in Toronto.

Bob Delaney has long taken a close personal interest in working with communities of new Canadians, serving on the Board of the Peel Multicultural Council, and as a volunteer with the Inter-Cultural Neighbourhood Social Services in Mississauga.
